Fully describe the business's activities?

The business generates income by hosting weddings, functions and other events on a holistic basis, offering turnkey solutions from venue setup and infrastructure, chapel facilities, luxury accommodation, to catering, etc. The venue has earned an outstanding reputation as a sought-after wedding destination with versatile facilities that cater for intimate gatherings as well as large-scale celebrations.

Established flower farming operations yields generous secondary income whilst the unique botanical setting creates an unmatched visual backdrop that distinguishes the venue from competitors.

How long has the business been established?

The owners developed the property from 2002 with initial infrastructure and flower orchards which have been exceptionally maintained and expanded over the years.

Provide more details on the Estate?

The property expands 21.4 hectares and upon entering the estate, visitors are transformed to a picturesque haven of natural beauty. A mature tree-lined avenue lead through flower fields, citrus orchards and lavender gardens making for exceptional and scenic photo sessions.

Two large reception venues seat 150 and 60 guests respectively, featuring farmstead-style architecture, chandeliers, fairy lighting, verandas, welcome areas, fully equipped cash bar and industrial kitchens. Ceremony options include an indoor chapel seating 120 guests and an outdoor bush chapel seating 150 guests. Other infrastructure include two bomas, a man cave, bridal ready-room, salon and laundry facilities. Accommodation can host up to 54 guests in 19 stylish facilities including a honeymoon suite, a two-bedroom apartment, family rooms, double rooms and dormitories with communal kitchen and ablutions, catering for all budgets.

The property also includes an upmarket five-bedroom main residence and two two-bedroom houses.

Various storerooms and worker accommodation completed the business-end of the property.

Elaborate on farming operations and infrastructure?

Productive farming of flowers, mainly proteas and fynbos, in expansive orchards of matured trees and young newly planted trees. Flowers are used as part of the wedding offering and sold in the open market.

Infrastructure include strong boreholes, tanks, pumps, irrigation, large water reservoir and two ground fishing dams. Sustainable electricity infrastructure with a generator and three solar systems.

Normal event coordination activities and preparations
Inspect and maintain wedding decor and equipment
Procure supplies for catering
